**Figure S1.** Platelets do not accumulate in the normal tissues of human intestine. To determine whether platelets accumulated in the normal tissues of human intestine, immunofluorescent staining of CD41-positive platelets, CK8-positive intestinal epithelium cells and DAPI-positive cell nuclei was performed. A number of platelets deposited in the tumor tissues (the upper right tissue). However, platelet accumulation was deficient in the normal tissues of human intestine (the lower left tissue) .
